WHEREAS, the citizens of the Dr. Ellis Subdivision in the City of Urbana, particularly on North Romine, pay taxes to and support the City; and

WHEREAS, the condition of North Romine and some adjacent streets have become both unsafe and difficult to travel; and

WHEREAS, the calm of the neighborhood is threatened in myriad ways by the condition of the street and the constant passage of MTD buses; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of said neighborhood have an equal right with every other citizen to have both their state of mind and physical surroundings protected from avoidable incursions; and


WHEREAS, this City Council acts to protect its citizens in all practicable ways;

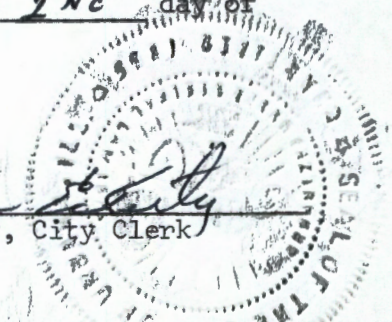
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that:

The Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District is hereby urged to re-route its vehicles of the "Blue Line" from North Romine to another, less destructive, route; and


