

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the structure on the following described premises was inspected by Everett Johnson and found to be a dangerous building:

The North 50 feet Lot 1 and the North 50 feet of the E1/2 of Lot 2 in Block 12 of the Seminary Addition to Urbana, Illinois,

commonly known as 1109 North Goodwin, Urbana, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Urbana Savings & Loan Association is the record owner of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice together with a copy of the said Ordinance was duly mailed to the record owner, Urbana Savings & Loan Association, 110 East Main, Urbana, Illinois, on July 27, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
