commonly known as 906 Wascher Drive, Urbana, Illinois, and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Max L. and M. Joanne Henson are the record owners of the said premises, subject to a mortgage to Gibson Federal Savings and Loan Association, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice together with a copy of the said Ordinance was duly mailed to the record owners, Max L. and M. Joanne Henson, 100 N. Henson, Villa Grove, Illinois, on July 28, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.


