IN URBANA, ILLINOIS


WHEREAS, there is a continued shortage of housing for the elderly in the City of Urbana; and

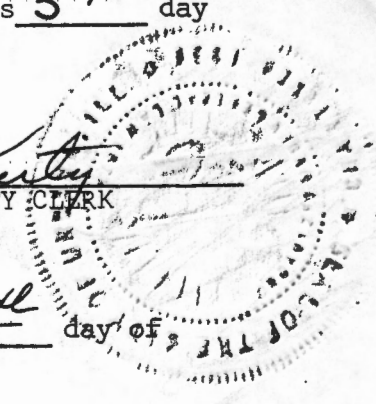
WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of Champaign County is charged with the responsibility of providing low cost and elderly housing in Champaign County;

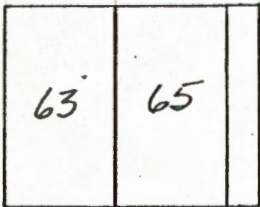
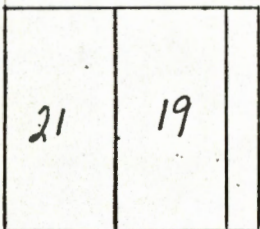
AN AMENDMENT TO A PART OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS



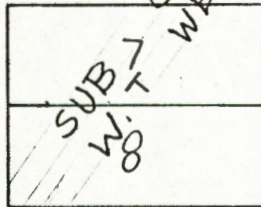
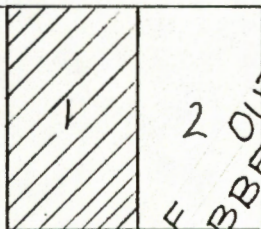
MAIN STREET
