

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A DEPOSIT
ON BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

WHEREAS, the solid waste disposal is a critical problem in the cities of Champaign-Urbana, and the Pollution Control Board has required more stringent control which will result in higher operating costs; and

WHEREAS, suitable landfill sites are in short supply causing higher acquisition costs; and


WHEREAS, the need to conserve natural resources is generally recognized; and

WHEREAS, unsightly littering discredits the community and creates costs that burden the taxpayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE URBANA City Council acknowledges the need for legislation to encourage recycling and reuse and to encourage wise use of natural resources and to discourage littering and its associated costs and to reduce the costs of solid waste disposal; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the URBANA City Council hereby declares its support for and endorsement of legislation and/or regulation on a national or state level, but not on a local level, requiring a deposit on soft drink and malt beverage containers to encourage reusable containers and recycling and to discourage littering.
