

RESOLUTION FOR LEASED FAMILY HOUSING  
IN URBANA, ILLINOIS


WHEREAS, there is a continued shortage of leased family housing in the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of Champaign County is charged with the responsibility of providing leased family housing in Champaign County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:


That we urge the Housing Authority to get authorization for the leasing of 50 family housing units in the City of Urbana, 10 of which to be 2 bedroom units, 35 of which to be 3 bedroom units, and 5 of which to be 4 bedroom units, and that the location of these leased family housing units be developed on scattered sites in the City of Urbana, and that the family housing be limited to no more than 12 units per site.
