WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Clarence and Millie Anderson are the record owners of the said premises, subject to Busey First National Bank, and

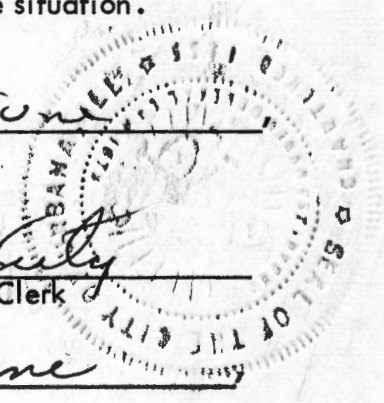
WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice together with a copy of the said Ordinance was duly mailed to the record owner, Clarence Anderson, 708 North Ash Street, Champaign, Illinois, on November 1, 1971, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, he has apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
