

RESOLUTION CONCERNING DISPOSITION OF A CERTAIN AMOUNT
OF REVENUE SHARING FUNDS

WHEREAS, since the City of Urbana, Illinois, has pressing needs in the area of social services, and

WHEREAS, since a study of such needs has been made by a committee of the Urbana City Council, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council finds that the most pressing needs relate to health care services for low income group, counseling for drug abusers, social services for the elderly who are black, a feasibility study on establishing a Health Maintenance organization, telephone service for information on social agencies, assistance to the educational and social development of preschool children, assistance in the purchase of a halfway house for boys released from State institutions, and a special job training program for the unskilled,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:


1. The total sum of \$72,700.00 is herewith allocated to provide for social services as specified above, but not limited to such specified services, applications and uses, except as limited by contract as hereafter provided.

2. The Urbana City Council's Revenue Sharing Committee shall meet with the Joint Review Committee of the Champaign County Mental Health Board (708) and shall thereafter make specific recommendations as to appropriations to be made by the City Council pursuant to this Resolution.


3. In the event the two specified Committees cannot agree upon the allocation of funds, the Urbana City Council's Committee on Revenue Sharing shall so report to the City Council and shall seek aid and directions.

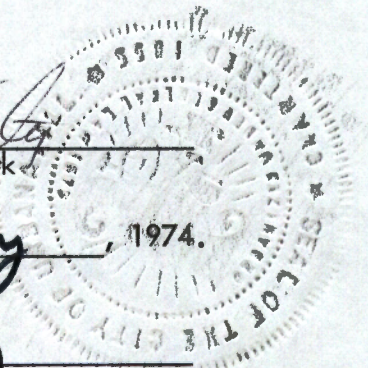
4. Funds so appropriated shall be distributed to each such recipient agency only pursuant to a joint contract among the recipient agency, the City of Urbana and the Champaign County Mental Health Board (708).

The City Council is prepared to allocate \$72,700 for social services in the Urbana-Champaign area.

It is the intent of the Council to use the funds to provide health services for low income groups, counseling for drug abusers, social services for the elderly who are black, a feasibility study on establishing a Health Maintenance organization, a special telephone line for information on social development of pre-school children, help in purchase of a halfway house for boys released from state institutions, and a special job training program for the unskilled.

A recommendation for the The allocation of the funds shall be made by the Council's Revenue Sharing Committee and the Joint Review Committee of the Champaign County Mental Health Board. If the two committees are unable to agree on how any of the funds are to be allocated, the Revenue Sharing Committee shall return to the City Council for further direction. *All recommendations for allocations by approved by the City Council.*
