and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that C. T. Henson is the record owner of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owner, C. T. Henson, 707 Hessel, Champaign, Illinois 61820 on December 12, 1973, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, he has apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.


