RESOLUTION ON "UN-CAR DAY"

Earth Week will be April 21 to April 27, 1974, at the beginning of the Spring season.

As part of Earth Week activities it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, to declare Tuesday, April 23, 1974, as


"UN-CAR DAY"


The advantages to be gained include money savings, use of less fuel, less pollutants emitted, and better health.
