WHEREAS, the authorized level of services in the 1974-75 fiscal year City of Urbana budget provides for an overall level of services that is at long last reasonable in view of overdue maintenance problems within the City, and


WHEREAS, to continue to provide this same level of services in future years may require increases in tax revenues, and

WHEREAS, the great rate of inflation now makes uncertain the needed level of tax rates to provide the income necessary to maintain the currently authorized level of services,

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that prior to additional increases in taxes for the General Operating Fund of the City, consideration will be given to the reduction of personnel and services.


