RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the structure on the following described premises was inspected by Everett Johnson and was found to be a dangerous building:

The North 132 feet of the East 300 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, situated in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 1200 North Goodwin Street, Urbana, Illinois,

and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Max L. Henson and Joanne Henson are the record owners of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owners, Max L. Henson and Joanne Henson, 206 Henson Road, Villa Grove, Illinois 61956 on April 3, 1974, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and


WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
