

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the structure on the following described premises was inspected by Everett Johnson and was found to be a dangerous building:

Commencing at a point 109 1/2 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 21 of N.W. Davis' Second Addition to the City of Urbana, and running thence East 54 3/4 feet, thence running South 142.66 feet thence running West 54 3/4 feet and thence running North to the place of beginning, in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 911 East Water Street, Urbana, Illinois,

and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that John L. and Doris I. Franklin are the record owners of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owners, John L. and Doris I. Franklin, 1906 Easy Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801, on May 20, 1974, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation,


