

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The following question be submitted to the voters of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at the first general or regular election occurring at least seventy-eight (78) days after the adoption of this Resolution.

Should the Office of City Treasurer be appointive rather than elective effective upon the expiration of the current term?

Section 2. Election Judges and polling places shall be the same as are to be used in the general or regular election at which the above proposal is submitted; the opening and closing of the polls shall also be the same as are observed in the election at which the above proposal is submitted.

Section 3. The ballot shall be printed on opaque white paper of sufficient size that when folded evenly once, the language setting forth the proposition shall appear entirely below the fold.

Section 4. The form of the ballot shall be substantially as follows:

Section 5. Notice of Election. The City Clerk shall publish Notice of Election concerning the above proposal at the same times and in the same manner as the Notice of Election for Municipal Officers; the Clerk shall also publish a sample copy of the ballot at least once prior to the election at which it is to be voted upon.

Section 6. It is the duty of the City Clerk to assure the preparation of sufficient ballots for such election.
