

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that a solution to the west Urbana parking problem has been affected by a partial parking ban as passed by the City Council this 1st day of MAY, 1975.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is not the intent of the City Council to require this solution be a permanent solution to any parking problem which presently exists or which may exist in the future in this area. It is therefore the intent of the City Council to request the Mayor to appoint a Committee to perform the following:

1. Review the total problem of parking within this area and in fact the area of the whole City.
2. To prepare a comprehensive plan for solving the parking problems which exist in this and other areas.
3. In deliberating upon these solutions, the Committee shall consult with all affected governmental agencies, citizen groups, and individuals, including but not limited to the University of Illinois, the Champaign County Mass Transit Authority, fraternities, sororities, single-family residences, multiple-family residences, and any other interested individual.
4. That included in any comprehensive plan for solving this problem, the Committee should also consider the feasibility of alternate parking, such as parking ramps and lots that may be constructed in this area.
