


RESOLUTION

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,
that:


1. As far as major street planning is concerned, give highest priority to improving the Windsor-Lincoln Bypass, exactly as suggested in Point #1 of J. P. Neal's Communication dated June 25, 1975.
2. Open Vine Street now to allow for two lanes of traffic on temporary blacktop (tar and chips), using the city easement.
3. Immediately thereafter, initiate the acquisition of the entire street right-of-way for the 2100 block of South Vine Street, and, as soon as reasonably possible, have it permanently paved as a residential street with not more than two 11' driving lanes.
4. Erect signs barring through-truck traffic at every entrance to the purely residential area within Florida, Philo Road, Windsor and Race.
5. Designate Vine Street south of Florida as a "collector", rather than an arterial or major street.
6. Close the file of the Urban Plan Commission on Case #950.
