RESOLUTION DENOUNCING UNITED NATIONS
GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION CONCERNING ZIONISM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

The Council deplores and condemns the United Nations General Assembly Resolution which equates Zionism and racism. The resolution unjustly libels the State of Israel and evokes the fear of official international approval of anti-semitism in all its evil forms. As such it is also a vicious attack upon Jews of all nations. The resolution is contrary to the spirit and purpose of the United Nations Charter and seriously undermines the moral and ethical principles upon which the United Nations is founded.

We express concurrence with the strong condemnation of the resolution voiced by President Ford, Ambassador Moynihan, both houses of Congress, religious and lay leaders of all faiths, and the free world press.
