

RESOLUTION FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR CITY OF NAPERVILLE CASE
ON SUBDIVISION LAND DONATION REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Naperville, Illinois, has passed a home rule ordinance requiring subdividers to donate land, or money in lieu thereof, for school and park purposes; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance has been challenged in the Courts, requiring a substantial defense fund; and


WHEREAS, it may be in the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana for the City Council of Urbana to pass a similar ordinance:


