

RESOLUTION ON NUMBER OF VOTES NEEDED TO PASS  
A RESOLUTION OR MOTION NOT COVERED BY ORDINANCE 7374-61


WHEREAS, certain resolutions and motions that come before the Urbana City Council do not require a statutory number of votes for final passage, and therefore do not fall under the requirements of Ordinance 7374-61; and

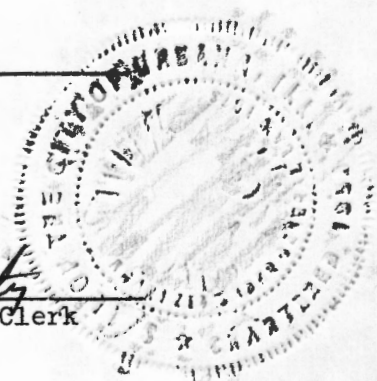
WHEREAS, it is the belief of the City Council that the final vote on any resolution or motion should require a sufficient number of votes for passage so that there is no doubt that a substantial number of the members of the City Council support said resolution or motion:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that it should be a rule of the City Council that resolutions and motions not covered by Ordinance 7374-61 shall require the same majority vote for passage as is required by Ordinance 7374-61; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be deemed to pass only if it receives at least eight votes, according to the voting provisions of Ordinance 7374-61, and that it may be repealed by a similar vote.
