Resolution No. 7576-R6 RESOLUTION OF INTENT WHEREAS, the CCDC Foundation has presented a Challenge Grant Proposal to the City of Urbana offering \$10,000.00, provided that the City of Urbana matches it with \$20,000.00, and WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Challenge Grant that the City of Urbana engage in a project that will enhance the environmental quality of the City, and WHEREAS, a Citizens Advisory Committee was appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, and has recommended that an information center be constructed on Cunningham Avenue at the County of Champaign "Outlook" property, and WHEREAS, the land has been appraised at \$10,000.00, said \$10,000.00 being applicable toward the City's \$20,000.00 of matching funds, and WHEREAS, other financial contributions will be sought from interested citizens and businesses within the City of Urbana, and WHEREAS, the proposed project will enhance the appearances of a major gateway to the City of Urbana and offer a valuable service to visitors to the City of Urbana, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City Council finds and determines that the proposed 1. information center will bring benefit to the City of Urbana and enhance the environmental quality of North Cunningham Avenue. That the City Council intends to amend the Annual Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year 1975-76 to authorize an expenditure of \$5,000.00 for the said project during FY 1975-76. 2. The City Council further intends to authorize the expenditure of an additional \$5,000.00 in the Annual Budget Ordinance 3. for Fiscal Year 1976-77. 4. The City Council expresses its appreciation to the CCDC Foundation for its proposing the challenge and for its contributing \$10,000.00 to the project. The City Council expresses its appreciation to the County Board of Champaign County for leasing to the City of Urbana the site for the proposed information center, valued as a \$10,000.00 contribution toward the City's matching funds. The City Council expresses its appreciation to the Citizens Advisory Committee and to their Chairwoman, Frances Hinesly, and to other citizens, for their outstanding efforts on this project, on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.
