

RESOLUTION NO. 7576-R-27A

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PROPOSAL
FOR THE EXTENSION OF VINE STREET
SOUTH OF FLORIDA AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has heretofore, on the 7th day of July, 1975, resolved to open Vine Street from George Huff Drive to Holmes Street using a city easement; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has heretofore, on the 12th day of August, 1975, resolved to pave said proposed area of Vine Street with thirty (30) feet portland concrete paving between mountable curbs, the intent being to provide two eleven (11) foot driving lanes and, on the east side, one eight (8) foot stall lane; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has prepared various options containing either a sixty-six (66) or a thirty-three (33) foot right of way for said proposed area of Vine Street, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that:

Option 2 of said proposals, which provides for a thirty (30) foot P.C.C. pavement with mountable curbs, an alignment along centerline, and a four (4) foot sidewalk on both sides, all of which are to be within a sixty-six (66) foot right of way, is hereby approved.
