

The STATE and the CITY have previously entered into an agreement for improving Florida Avenue (FAU Route 8320) from Cottage Grove Avenue to James Cherry Drive and Philo Road (ILL. Route 130) from 736' South of Florida Avenue to Briar Cliff Drive in Urbana designated as City Section 186-CS, State Section 200 1. The improvement consists of constructing an 8" PCC standard reinforced pavement 44' face to face of curb and variable on Florida Avenue, constructing 9" BAM widening to 64' face to face of curb and variable on Philo Road, C-4 median, left turn lanes, and traffic signals on both streets, and whereas, the joint agreement provides that the CITY will furnish the Resident Engineer during construction and cause the subject section to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract and whereas in order to assure continued advancement of this improvement, which is desired and which will be of benefit to the residents. of Urbana, the STATE agrees to provide a Resident Engineer for the section, inasmuch as the CITY has been unable to find anyone who is qualified to. serve as a Resident Engineer on this project and would be available on a full time basis.

This letter and the acceptance thereof by the CITY and the STATE shall constitute an agreement and shall set forth responsibilities of both the CITY and the STATE. These responsibilities are as follows:

- 1. The STATE agrees to furnish a competent employee of adequate ability and experience to serve as Resident Engineer.
- 2. The CITY agrees that reimbursement to the STATE shall be in the actual amount of salary (to include overtime at 150% of the base rate), insurance, social security and travel expenses for the Resident Engineer provided by the STATE.
- It is mutually agreed that the reimbursement to the STATE, for the Resident Engineering, shall be made by the CITY as soon as practicable after each monthly billing.

4. It is further mutually agreed that this agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

If the conditions contained herein are acceptable to the CITY, it is requested that the City Council pass a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign this agreement in behalf of the CITY and return one of the two copies to this office, along with the ordinance.
