

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO TAKE SUCH STEPS AS ARE ADMINISTRATIVELY NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO TRANSFER THE FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARKING ADMINISTRATOR TO OTHER DEPARTMENTS AND DIVISIONS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana has determined that it is no longer in the best interests of the City to have an established Parking Commission inasmuch as the duties of said commission might be handled more efficiently by other departments and divisions of the City, and


WHEREAS, the City Council has duly repealed those Sections of the Urbana City Code establishing said Parking Commission and providing for its meetings and duties, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly amended other Sections of the Urbana City Code and the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance to thereby remove certain authority which heretofore has been vested in said Parking Commission,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the Mayor is hereby and herewith authorized and directed to take such steps as are administratively necessary or appropriate to transfer the functions, duties and responsibilities currently entrusted in the Parking Administrator by Sections 2.60 and 2.62 of the Urbana City Code to other departments and/or divisions of the City, provided, however, that nothing contained in this Resolution shall be deemed to authorize any action that might be inconsistent with the express provisions of the Ordinance authorizing and providing for the issue of Motor Vehicle Parking System Revenue Parking Bonds, which was duly passed by the City Council on June 14, 1963 and approved by the Mayor on June 14, 1963.
