

RESOLUTION NO. 7576-R59B

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NEGOTIATION  
WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION  
OF THE INFORMATION CENTER

WHEREAS, available funds for the purpose of constructing an information center in the City of Urbana are scarce and a number of donations therefor are anticipated; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that contracts in excess of \$1,500 may be entered into by proper officers without advertising for bids, if authorized by a vote of two-thirds of all the aldermen or trustees then holding office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the proper officers be and hereby are authorized to enter into such contracts as are necessary or appropriate for the construction of the information center without advertising for bids.

This resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a two-thirds majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7th day of June, 1976.
