BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Agreement Amending Agreement Concerning  
Cost of Operation of the City Dump of Urbana, Illinois, and to the  
Various Agreements Concerning Purchase of Dumping Ground, and to Other  
Amending Agreements Thereto, a copy of which is attached hereto and  
hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby accepted  
and approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana be and the  
same is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Urbana,  
Illinois, said agreement.

AGREEMENT AMENDING AGREEMENT CONCERNING COST OF OPERATION  
OF THE CITY DUMP OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AND TO THE VARIOUS  
AGREEMENTS CONCERNING PURCHASE OF DUMPING GROUND, AND TO  
OTHER AMENDING AGREEMENTS THERETO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois, a public corporation, hereinafter referred to as the University, entered into an agreement under date of June 19, 1950, entitled "AGREEMENT CONCERNING COST OF OPERATION OF THE CITY DUMP OF URBANA, ILLINOIS" with the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the City, permitting the University to use the City Dump providing a prorated portion of the cost of its operation is paid to the City by the University; and

WHEREAS, the agreement has been amended on October 5, 1954; December 9, 1960; November 16, 1970; June 19, 1974; and January 19, 1976; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to further amend the agreement so that operational costs will be shared by all users to reflect the regional use of the Urbana Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the University's share of landfill operating costs will be in proportion to the University's use of the Urbana landfill; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Champaign and Urbana have established a joint solid waste disposal system, the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System for the establishment, operation, and main-



tenance of solid waste disposal facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the University and the City of Urbana agree to amend the aforesaid agreement, and amendments to said agreement, as follows:

1. All references in the agreement and subsequent amendments thereto to "city dump" will be deleted and the words, "sanitary landfill" substituted therein.

2. Operating costs will herein be defined as all other costs not related to capital improvements. Such costs will include, but not be limited to, non-fixed equipment purchase, equipment rentals, labor costs, material and parts costs, overhead costs directly related to operations, and landfill consultant service costs.

3. The University's share of landfill operating costs (excluding capital improvements) will be payable at the end of each fiscal quarter, beginning July 1, 1976.

(a) The following formula shall be used to calculate the University's sanitary landfill operating cost:

$$\text{University operating cost} = \text{gross operating cost} \times \frac{\text{University refuse volume or weight total}}{\text{refuse volume or weight}}$$

(b) For the first year that this amendment is effective, beginning July 1, 1976, the University's contribution will be 11.6% of sanitary landfill operating costs. That is, the ratio of

$$\frac{\text{University refuse volume or weight total}}{\text{refuse volume or weight}} \times 100\% \text{ is } 11.6\%$$



a ratio based upon data obtained from the 1973 Champaign County Solid Waste Management Study. An adjustment shall be made for the year beginning July 1, 1977, for discrepancies between the 1973 established ratio and the actual ratio obtained for the July 1, 1976, to June 30, 1977, period. After the first adjustment is made the ratio shall be based upon volume or weight data reported from the prior year.

4. Contribution of the University's share of landfill costs will be contingent upon all appropriate provisions of law and the availability of funds to the University which may be applied to landfill costs.

5. (a) The City of Urbana, acting individually or acting as a member of the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System, said System hereby being recognized and authorized to operate and maintain the sanitary landfill and sanitary landfill equipment pursuant to the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement, will assure that the sanitary landfill is operational in such manner as to provide for disposal of University refuse on the lowest optimal cost.

(b) In the event that the City of Champaign and the City of Urbana, acting pursuant to the Champaign-Urbana Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement, agree to transfer solid waste disposal facilities to the System for the operation and maintenance of the sanitary landfill, the following table summarizes the amounts of the proposed transfers:

\*Salvage value of \$10,000. Title at salvage point to University of Illinois and Urbana.

The University and the City of Urbana shall then receive credits from the System in the amounts of \$55,220 and \$212,930, respectively. The System shall within sixty (60) days of the signing of this amendatory agreement transmit to the University a certified copy of a resolution indicating acceptance of a transfer pursuant to this paragraph 5(b).


