RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF AN APPLICATION FOR AND RECEIPT OF A COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE CITIES OF CHAMPAIGN AND URBANA, ILLINOIS, UNDER SECTION 701 OF THE HOUSING ACT OF 1954, AS AMENDED, BY THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS WITH FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Local Government Affairs has applied for and received a grant for federal funds under Title VII, Section 701 of the Housing Act of 1954, as amended, to aid in the financing of comprehensive planning assistance in Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Champaign and Urbana, Illinois, have created a Citizens Study Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation, and

WHEREAS, the Study Commission has been organized and has established as its general purpose to foster a common direction among the governing bodies of Champaign County to promote efficient use of tax monies and effective delivery of service, and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Champaign and Urbana have each appropriated \$5,000 for the support of the Commission's activities, and

WHEREAS, the Study Commission has requested the Cities of Champaign and Urbana to act as a grant applicant in accordance with federal and state regulations, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has given due consideration to said application for federal assistance, Standard Form No. 424.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposed application for a comprehensive planning assistance grant under Section 701 of the Federal Housing Act of 1954, as amended, by the Illinois Department of Local Government Affairs with federal funds provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development whereby the Study Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation is authorized to undertake the comprehensive planning assistance activities, the City of Urbana is authorized to be the recipient of the grant award document, and the Cities of Champaign and Urbana will provide a sum not to exceed \$10,000 in services as the one-third matching share of the total cost of the planning program is hereby approved.



Dear Professor Gove:

In accordance with George Dinges letter of April 30 to Mayor Hiram Paley, the Department of Local Government Affairs has authorized \$20,000 for assistance to the Cities of Champaign and Urbana for the activities of the Study Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation.

As a follow-up to our telephone conversation, this letter is to advise you that the grant will be provided on a reimbursable basis, and will be phased over two fiscal years. The first phase of the program will encompass the time period from July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977. The second phase will begin July 1, 1977 and end no later than June 30, 1978.

Enclosed are copies of Standard Form 425 and the resolutions of authorization which serve as the formal application for funding assistance. They have been written to provide for a joint application from the cities, and for the City of Urbana to be the grant recipient. If the commission determines that some other entity should be the recipient, please revise the forms accordingly.

In addition to these signed application forms, we will need a copy of the work program, and the proposed budget. Both of those items should reflect the fiscal year split. Also, you will need to submit a letter of intent to the metropolitan A-95 clearinghouse--the Champaign County Regional Planning Commission.

These actions will enable us to process the grant and allow the commission to begin billing the department for costs incurred. As I noted during our telephone conversation, any costs incurred since July 1 will be eligible for reimbursement, as long as the activities are provided for in the work program.
