A RESOLUTION TO URBANA
SCHOOL BOARD - DISTRICT 116

WHEREAS maintaining the integrity of neighborhoods is necessary to the security and personal welfare of Urbana's citizens; and

WHEREAS the threat to close schools creates a negative effect upon the people directly affected; and


WHEREAS Urbana is committed to careful planning in order to maintain safe and viable neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS people who are directly affected would like the Plan Commission to consider the overall impact of school closing on the community.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as follows:
