- 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Urbana.

## AGREEMENT CONCERNING PARKING METER COSTS ON MARYLAND DRIVE BETWEEN PENNSYLVANIA AND FLORIDA AND ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF COLLEGE COURT FROM MARYLAND TO VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois, a public corporation, hereinafter referred to as the University, and the City of Urbana, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the City, have ascertained that since 1967 the University has collected parking meter revenues for parking on City streetright-of-way located on Maryland Drive between Pennsylvania and Florida Avenues and on the south side of College Court from Maryland to Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the City has alleged that a portion of the net parking revenues from said meters belongs to the City from the date of installation through June 30, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the University denies that any portion of the revenues belong to said City, and

WHEREAS, the City and the University are desirous of making a final settlement regarding such net parking revenues collected from said meters.

NOW, THEREFORE, the University and the City agree as follows:

- The meters on said streets belong to University and may be removed upon termination of this agreement.
- 2. The University will pay the City a sum of \$7,000.00 in full and final settlement of all meter revenues collected from said meters from date of their installation through June 30, 1976.
- 3. The University will pay the City fifty (50) per cent of the total net revenues from said meters for the period July 1, 1976 through June 30, 1977.
- 4. The University will pay the City in each fiscal year subsequent to year ending June 30, 1977, fifty (50) per cent of the net meter revenues from said meters. Such payments to be made within 90 days after the close of the University's fiscal year.

Net revenues shall mean gross revenues from said meters less applicable operating, maintenance, enforcement and administrative costs relating thereto.

This agreement may be terminated upon 60 day's notice by either party.
