A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT
TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS AND THE URBANA LODGE #70
OF THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Agreement Amending Appendix "B"
of the Agreement between the City of Urbana, Illinois and the
Urbana Lodge #70 of the Fraternal Order of Police, dated the 29th
day of September, 1975, a copy of which Amendment is attached
hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is
hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois,
be and the same is hereby authorized to sign and execute said
amending Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

AN AGREEMENT AMENDING APPENDIX "B"
OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS AND THE URBANA LODGE
#70 OF THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE,
DATED THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1975

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 18.1, entitled, "Reopening", of the Agreement entered into the 29th day of September, 1975, between the City of Urbana, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and the Urbana Lodge #70 of the Fraternal Order of Police (hereinafter referred to as the "Lodge"), makes provision whereby the Lodge may notify the City in writing of its desire to reopen the Agreement; provided such reopener shall be limited to Articles 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16 and 17 together with Appendix "B" of said Agreement for the year July 1, 1976 through and including June 30, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the Lodge duly notified the City in writing of its desire to so reopen the Agreement on May 3, 1976, a date within the period specified in Article XVIII, Section 18.1, of the Agreement to do so; and

WHEREAS, upon such notice being given, the duly authorized representatives of both the City and the Lodge met for the purpose of negotiating in good faith the items so specified for the year July 1, 1976 through and including June 30, 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the City and the Lodge do mutually covenant and agree to amend Appendix "B" of the Agreement as follows:

Effective July 1, 1976, through and including December 31, 1976, the base salary for employees covered by this Agreement, determined herein as the annual base and represented in both annual and hourly rates (based upon 2,080 hours per year) shall be as follows:

	<u>Annual</u>	<u>Hourly</u>
Police Officer (non-probationary)	\$12,407	\$5.965
Police Corporal	\$13,007	\$6.254
Police Sergeant	\$13,607	\$6.542

Effective January 1, 1977, through and including June 30, 1977, the base salary for employees covered by this Agreement, determined herein as the annual base and represented in both annual and hourly rates (based upon 2,080 hours per year) shall be as follows:

	<u>Annual</u>	<u>Hourly</u>
Police Officer	\$12,779	\$6.144
Police Corporal	\$13,379	\$6.433
Police Sergeant	\$13,979	\$6.721

The City and the Lodge both acknowledge that the foregoing amended schedules establishing the annual base salary as represented in both annual and hourly rates (based upon 2,080 hours per year) for the periods July 1, 1976 through and including December 31, 1976, and January 1, 1977 through and including June 30, 1977, constitute all of the amendments to the Agreement under Article XVIII, Section 18.1 of the Agreement entitled, "Reopening", and that this amendment, together with the remainder of the Agreement, shall govern the salaries and all other benefits and conditions of employment covered by this Agreement for the year July 1, 1976 through and including June 30, 1977.
