

RESOLUTION NO. 7778-R-10

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF
THE CITY COUNCIL TO COMMIT CERTAIN
FUNDS FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 1978

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to continue the Community Development Program as heretofore approved, established and maintained under the federal Housing and Community Development Act and to again apply for assistance for certain specified projects for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Park District has expressed an interest in expanding and making improvements to Martin Luther King Park, a park located within the target area of the Urbana Community Development Program; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Park District is eligible to apply for a grant from the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, as administered by the Illinois Department of Conservation, to effect such an expansion of Martin Luther King Park and is able to apply secondary federal grant funds, such as those funds granted under the federal Housing and Community Development Act, to meet the requirement of matching funds for such a grant.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That it is the sense of the City Council that it will authorize and direct the Mayor of the City of Urbana to file an Application for Federal Assistance for a Community Development Program under the Housing and Community Development Act for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, which said application shall include sufficient funds to be used and employed as matching funds for and on behalf of the Urbana Park District in order that the acquisition of certain described household properties, as shown on the attached sheet, option B, and the subsequent relocation of households accompany such properties might be effected in accordance with applicable law and regulation.

2. That the City of Urbana and the Urbana Park District proceed to jointly study the area immediately to the north of

Martin Luther King Park for its possible residential and/or recreational development.



KING PARK EXPANSION OPTIONS




City Share - \$155,650
