

RESOLUTION NO. 7778-R17

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING OCTOBER 31, 1977,
AS THE OFFICIAL DATE FOR HALLOWEEN OBSERVANCE
IN URBANA, ILLINOIS


WHEREAS, the Champaign and Urbana PTA Councils, the Mayors and Police Departments are recommending that Monday, October 31, 1977, be designated as the official date for observance of Halloween; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council recognizes the desirability of designating a common date for said observance to best promote the safety of children, and convenience of householders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Monday, October 31, 1977, shall be officially designated as Halloween in the City of Urbana, and that the hours for Halloween treating shall be from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
2. That parents are encouraged to accompany children as they make their treating rounds in familiar neighborhoods.
3. That children be encouraged not to eat unwrapped candy or fruit.
4. That householders are encouraged to indicate their willingness to welcome neighborhood children by keeping their porch and exterior lights on so that children may call at homes only so lighted.
5. That special attention be given to traffic safety rules by motorists and children alike.
