

RESOLUTION NO. 7778-R27

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CONDITIONAL
FREE PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS AND
MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, pursuant to Section 17-1 of Article XVII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby authorized to effect a temporary change of the designated parking meter zones of the City so that the following streets or portions thereof and the areas within the following off-street parking lots of the City shall not be considered as a parking meter zone for the period commencing on November 25, 1977, through and including January 25, 1978, inclusively:

Plan A: Municipal Parking Lots 10A, 10B, 10E, 10F, and 10X, together with that portion of Broadway Avenue between Elm Street and Lincoln Square on the west side of said Avenue.

Plan B: That portion of Main Street between Cedar Street and Vine Street on both sides of said street; that portion of Broadway Avenue between Main Street and Water Street on both sides of the street; together with Municipal Parking Lots 3, 7, 8 and 15.

Section 2. That the authority granted the Mayor under Section 1 of this Resolution is expressly conditioned upon the payment of \$6,343.00 under Plan A and \$2,522.00 under Plan B, sums which must be irrevocably committed to be paid to the City of Urbana by certain members of the Urbana Business Community on or before the 25th day of November, 1977.

Section 3. That on and after January 25, 1978, the said streets, portions thereof, and areas within the off-street parking lots of the City as so specified in Section 1 of this Resolution shall be and the same are reestablished as designated parking meter zones pursuant to Section 17-1 of Article XVII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended.

Section 4. That this two-hour free parking plan is hereby considered an experiment whereby the City can evaluate the effects of two-hour free parking; the Council directs the administration at this

time to prepare and submit a plan for evaluation of the experiment to be presented at the subsequent Council meeting, December 5, 1977, and subsequently keep the Council informed of progress.
