A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NEGOTIATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF A STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM IN CENSUS TRACT 53 WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, Section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides that contracts in excess of \$1,500 may be entered into by proper officers without advertising for bids, if authorized by a vote of two-thirds of all the aldermen or trustees then holding office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the proper officers of the City of Urbana be and the same are hereby authorized to enter into such negotiations and contracts as may be necessary or appropriate for the construction of improvements to the street lighting system in Census Tract 53 without advertising for bids.

This resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a two-thirds, majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the <u>Sth</u> day of <u>Automotive</u>, 1977.
