NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that there is hereby appropriated the sum of Forty-nine thousand, nine hundred nineteen and 61/100 Dollars (\$ 49,919.61) from funds allotted to the municipality under the Motor Fuel Tax Law for the Payment of the above-described indebtedness, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk shall immediately transmit three (3) certified copies of this resolution to the District Engineer, Division of Highways, Department of Public Works and Buildings, at Paris, Illinois.

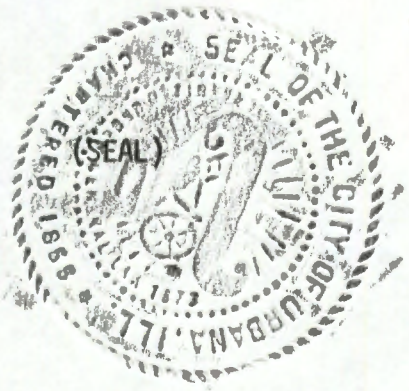
