

RESOLUTION NO. 7778-R45

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING A  
CITY SIDEWALK PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Environmental Committee of the Urbana City Council has recommended that the construction of sidewalks along both sides of all city streets be pursued as a city-wide policy; and

WHEREAS, a priority list needs to be established to serve and promote such sidewalk construction along those streets where the need for sidewalks is the greatest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the City Council hereby expresses its intent to pursue a program for the construction of sidewalks on a city-wide basis along both sides of all city streets.

2. That the sidewalks to be constructed under this program shall be constructed on a priority basis according to the priority list for such construction.

3. That the construction costs of any such sidewalk construction shall be apportioned in such a manner that all engineering costs shall be borne by the city and construction costs shall be borne by the adjacent property owner; this apportionment, which has heretofore been employed by the city for previous sidewalk construction projects within the city, normally results in an apportionment of overall costs wherein the city bears 30% and the adjacent property owner bears 70% of said overall costs.

4. That the adjoining property owners to such sidewalk construction be offered by the city the option to:

(a) directly undertake, subject to supervision of the City Engineer, construction of the adjacent sidewalk section.

(b) hire an independent contractor, which said contractor shall be subject to supervision of the City Engineer, to construct the adjacent sidewalk section.

(c) pay the cost of construction of adjacent sidewalk section by the city, which said payment shall be assessed in proportion to the property linear footage of the sidewalk improvement.
