

RESOLUTION NO. 7778-R60

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CONDITIONAL  
FREE PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS AND  
MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, pursuant to Section 17-1 of  
Article XVII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be  
and the same is hereby authorized to effect a temporary change of  
the designated parking meter zones of the City so that the following  
streets or portions thereof and the areas within the following  
off-street parking lots of the City shall not be considered as  
parking meter zones for the period commencing on May 25, 1978,  
*for* ~~through and including such time as a formal agreement is made~~  
*and ending August 25, 1978:*  
~~and entered into relative to parking and parking revenues for~~  
~~Lincoln Square Shopping Center:~~

Municipal Parking Lots 10A, 10B, 10E, 10F,  
and 10X, except that portion of Lot 10B  
located on Broadway Avenue between Elm  
Street and Lincoln Square on the east side  
of said Avenue.

Section 2. That the authority granted the Mayor under  
Section 1 of this Resolution is expressly conditioned upon the  
payment of 97.68% of the parking meter revenues derived by the  
City during the same period in fiscal year 1976-77, which said  
amount shall be irrevocably committed to be paid to the City of  
Urbana by Carson Pirie Scott and Company and Jewel Tea Company.  
If the remaining 2.32% of the said parking meter revenue is not  
committed to be paid by some other merchant in Lincoln Square, the  
Mayor is hereby authorized to reestablish for any period of such  
noncommitment a prorated amount of parking spaces in the municipal  
parking lots designated above as parking meter zones.
