
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL  
AGREEMENT PROVIDING A MUTUAL INSPECTION  
SCHEME FOR REFUSE HAULING VEHICLES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the Intergovernmental Agreement Providing a Mutual Inspection Scheme for Refuse Hauling Vehicles by and between the City of Urbana, Illinois and the City of Champaign, Illinois, a copy of which said Intergovernmental Agreement is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby approved.

2. That the Mayor of the City of Urbana be and the same is hereby authorized to execute said Intergovernmental Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Urbana.

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AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
PROVIDING A MUTUAL INSPECTION  
SCHEME FOR REFUSE HAULING VEHICLES

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between the City of Urbana and the City of Champaign, municipal corporations of the State of Illinois,

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Cities of Urbana and Champaign have heretofore entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement providing for a solid waste disposal system; and

WHEREAS, commercial-sanitary haulers must, in accordance with the applicable ordinances of both Urbana and Champaign, be properly licensed to engage in the collection of solid waste within each of the two cities; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Urbana and Champaign also now desire to make provision for the inspection of vehicles used in connection with the collection of solid waste prior to the issuance of any such license; and

WHEREAS, such inspection of refuse-hauling vehicles may be approached more effectively and economically on a uniform basis by consolidated efforts and resources; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Governmental Cooperation Act enable the parties hereto to enter into agreements among themselves and provide authority for intergovernmental cooperation on such a basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

Section 1. Definitions.

"Inspector" - means the designated official responsible for refuse-vehicle inspection and for the issuance of certificates thereof.

"Refuse-Hauling Vehicle" - shall mean any vehicle engaged in sanitary hauling or garbage collection including but not limited to the collection of ashes, debris, garbage, litter, refuse or rubbish, and all putrescible and nonputrescible solid wastes and solid market and industrial wastes.

Section 2.

To the extent required by ordinance in each of the Cities of Urbana and Champaign respectively, an inspection of all refuse-hauling vehicles operating in the Cities of Urbana and Champaign shall be conducted by an inspector mutually designated for such purposes by the respective Directors of Public Works. Any such inspection shall be conducted at such specified times and locations as may, from time to time, be designated and approved by the said Directors of Public Works. If any such inspections are conducted by one city for and on behalf of the other city, the city so conducting such inspections shall receive a five dollar (\$5.00) fee from the other city for each refuse-hauling vehicle so inspected.

Section 3.

All inspections made pursuant to this Agreement shall verify that the condition of any such refuse-hauling vehicle conforms with and meets the standards of all applicable laws, ordinances, rules or regulations of both the State of Illinois and the Cities of either Urbana or Champaign, respectively, relative to the condition and operation of any such vehicle.

Section 4.

The inspector so designated shall have the authority to inspect all refuse-hauling vehicles required to be licensed by either the City of Urbana or the City of Champaign. In addition, the designated inspector or his authorized representative shall have the authority to:

(a) sign and approve an inspection certificate for the individual refuse-hauling vehicle if the vehicle, upon the completion of such inspection, is found to be in compliance with all applicable requirements.

(b) keep such books and records relative to any such inspection or inspection fee as may be deemed necessary or appropriate by the respective Directors of Public Works.

Section 5.

(a) This Agreement shall become effective when duly executed by the City of Champaign and the City of Urbana.



(b) This Agreement shall be terminated by the City of Champaign and the City of Urbana thirty (30) days after the adoption by either city of a resolution declaring that the Agreement is terminated.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the cities has caused this Agreement to be duly executed and has attached herewith a copy of the ordinance or resolution so authorizing the signing official to execute this Agreement.
