

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION  
OF DUANE ECKERTY AS CITY CLERK OF THE  
CITY OF URBANA AND PROVIDING ADVICE AND  
CONSENT TO THE APPOINTMENT OF BEVERLY UMBARGER  
AS ACTING CITY CLERK

WHEREAS, by letter dated August 1, 1978, a copy of which said letter is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, Duane Eckerty has submitted his resignation from the office of City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for reasons of personal health, said resignation, if accepted, to be effective August 7, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of the above described resignation by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Urbana will, on and after such acceptance, cause a vacancy to occur in the office of city clerk; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-4-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (Ill. Rev. Stats., Ch. 24, § 3-4-2) provides that if a vacancy occurs in the office of city clerk, "it shall be filled by the mayor with the advice and consent of the city council", with the person so appointed holding office for the unexpired term of the officer previously elected; and

WHEREAS, in order that the day-to-day business and affairs of the City of Urbana and office of the city clerk might be conducted, it is imperative that a person be immediately appointed as acting city clerk to temporarily perform the duties and possess all the rights and powers of the city clerk until a permanent successor to fill the vacancy has been duly obtained and has qualified, all in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the temporary appointment of an acting city clerk until the office of city clerk is so duly filled in accordance with law is a matter directly pertaining to the government and affairs of the City of Urbana and within the scope of its home rule powers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Urbana has recommended to the City Council the appointment of Beverly Umbarger, the present duly appointed Deputy City Clerk, to be Acting City Clerk until a successor to the office of city clerk can be so duly filled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the resignation of Duane Eckerty from  
the office of the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois,  
be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby specifically  
finds and determines that such acceptance of the resignation of  
Duane Eckerty from the office of City Clerk causes a vacancy  
to occur in that office.

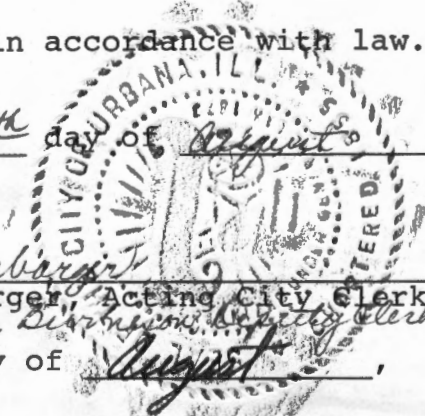
Section 3. That the City Council hereby provides its


