## AGREEMENT OF ADJACENT OWNERS FOR SURVEY

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana through the process of annexation has annexed the former township road commonly known as Wilbur Road; and

WHEREAS, the township records of Urbana Township and Somer Township regarding the original laying out of Wilbur Road are incomplete, lost or destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana and Terrance L. O'Neill are desirous of entering into an agreement pursuant to Section 11 of Chapter 133 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, 1977, to establish permanently the right-of-way line of Wilbur Road and to cause a plat thereof with a description of the right-of-way plainly marked thereupon together with a copy of this agreement to be recorded in the Recorder's Office of Champaign County, Illinois.

Commencing at a brass plug found at the Southeast corner of Section 31, Township 20 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois;

Thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West along the South line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 31, a distance of 1117.40 feet to the point of beginning; said point also being the Southwest corner of property conveyed to Twin City Roofing Company by deed dated February 27, 1970;

Thence North and Northeasterly along the centerline of a drainage ditch, said centerline also being the Westerly and Northerly lines of property described in said deed, to the centerline of the Saline Drainage Ditch, said centerline being the West line of sub-division filed for record January 20, 1969 as Document No. 787599 in Plat Book U in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois;

Thence Northerly along said centerline of said Saline Drainage Ditch, 350 feet, more or less to the Southeast corner of property conveyed to the National Protein Corp. by deed dated February 22, 1972;

Thence Westerly along the centerline of a drainage ditch tributary to the Saline Drainage Ditch, 782.0 feet, more or less, to the centerline of a drainage ditch tributary to said drainage ditch tributary to the Saline Drainage Ditch, said centerline of Saline Drainage Ditch and drainage ditch tributary to the Saline Drainage Ditch are witnessed by a meander line, all as shown on the plat filed for record February 8, 1972 as Document No. 72R1659 in Plat Book X, Page 70 in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois;

Thence North 69 degrees 03 minutes 50 seconds West 180.67 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of property conveyed to the National Protein Corp. by deed dated February 22, 1972;

Thence South 20 degrees 56 minutes 10 seconds West 631.18 feet to the South line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 31;

Thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 892.91 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that part lying Easterly of a line which is 850 feet distant Easterly from the Easterly line of the 200 feet operating property of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad Company, as measured perpendicularly to said operating property, said line also being the same as described in indenture, made 24th day of August, 1911, between Chicago Title and Trust Company and the Illinois Central Railroad Company and recorded in Book 148, Page 357 in Champaign County, Illinois.
