

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING A QUESTION OF PUBLIC
POLICY TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Cities of Urbana and Champaign are presently jointly considering a beverage container ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana deems such an ordinance to be of significant impact on the general public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires a direct indication of public attitude regarding the proposed ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the following public policy question shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Urbana at the General Election to be held on April 3, 1979:

Shall the City of Urbana require that non-refillable beverage containers sold within the City of Urbana have a refundable deposit value of ten cents?

2. That in all respects such submission shall be in accordance with applicable election law.
