

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FURTHER STUDY
AND CONSULTATION ON A PROPOSED LAND DEDICATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council recognizes the work of the Interagency Task Force (representing eight units of local government within Champaign County) and the Technical Advisory Review Panel in exploring the feasibility of an ordinance to provide for dedication of land (or fees in lieu) for neighborhood parks (and schools); and

WHEREAS, in order to be able to take appropriate action, it is first necessary to have a legally correct document drafted to conform to the language and format of the Subdivision Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, to advance intergovernmental cooperation and to simplify procedures for those persons concerned with land development in the Champaign-Urbana area, it is highly desirable to prepare an ordinance with uniform requirements for both Urbana and Champaign.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That, in the need for a joint effort and in the spirit of inter-city cooperation on this matter, the Urbana City Council requests its attorney to address this task forthwith in close consultation with the Attorney for the City of Champaign. The Council respectfully requests its sister council of the City of Champaign to similarly request its Attorney so that an appropriate document will be prepared and brought before both bodies for their consideration.
