

RESOLUTION NO. 7879-R54

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING
THE PLACES OF ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana has heretofore, by Resolution No. 7879-R47, determined that there shall be a regular election of officers of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, on the 3rd day of April, 1979, at which such election, there shall be elected a City Clerk who shall serve the balance of a four-year term beginning in 1977, and seven aldermen/alderwomen, each of which is to serve a four-year term; and

WHEREAS, by that same resolution, the City Council divided the City into seven election wards, directed the City Clerk to cause notice of said election, and appointed the Judges of Election for each such ward for the purpose of said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

For the purpose of said election, the City has been divided into seven wards, and the polling place designated for each of these wards shall be as follows:

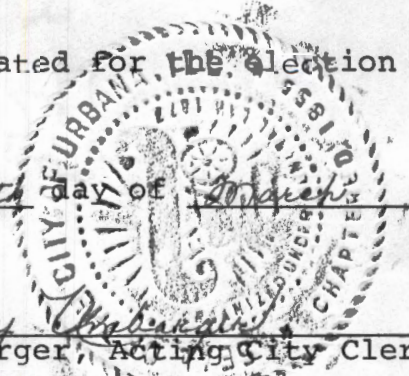
<u>1st Ward</u>	Florida Avenue Residence Hall West Lobby 1001 West College Court
<u>2nd Ward</u>	Illinois Street Residence Hall West Lobby 1010 West Illinois Street
<u>3rd Ward</u>	King School 1008 W. Fairview Avenue
<u>4th Ward</u>	Urbana High School North Entrance 1002 South Race Street
<u>5th Ward</u>	Webber Street Church of Christ Basement Off Main Lobby 107 South Webber Street
<u>6th Ward</u>	Steer Place South Entrance West Room 1201 East Colorado
<u>7th Ward</u>	Windsor Swim Club 704 Windsor Road

The polls at said election will be open at 6:00 A.M. and will be closed at 6:00 P.M. on the respective date of each election. Only qualified and registered voters shall be permitted to vote and
