

A RESOLUTION DECLARING
RESULTS OF ELECTION

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of April, 1979, there was held in and for the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, an election for the purpose of electing a City Clerk, who shall serve the balance of a four-year term beginning in 1977, and seven Aldermen/Alderwomen, and for the purpose of voting upon the question of whether to restrict the number of Aldermen/Alderwomen to one-half of the total authorized by Section 3-4-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code, with one Alderman/Alderwoman representing each ward; and

WHEREAS, the said election has been regularly called and held as provided by law, and the returns of said election and referendum, including the tally sheets, poll records, certificates of results, and other returns of said election have been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, and the returns are now before the City Council, and the said Council is familiar therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the election held on the 3rd day of April, 1979, was held in all respects as provided by law. Notice of said election was given by publishing the notice twice, once on March 16, 1979, in the Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette, and again on March 18, 1979, in the Champaign-Urbana Courier, which newspapers have general circulation within the City of Urbana, and which dates were not more than thirty days nor less than fifteen days in advance of the date of said election. The judges appointed by this City Council were duly qualified to fill such offices in each of the wards, and were duly sworn to perform their duties before the commencement of the said election. The returns of said election have been duly canvassed by said judges and the canvassing board and were filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana.

Section 2: The City Council finds from a canvass of the returns of said election that the following votes were cast in each of the said wards in favor of the following persons and referendum at said election:

HILARY W. MOORE to be elected as Alderman in the Third Ward of the City of Urbana.

BERNADINE EVANS STAKE to be elected as Alderwoman in the Fourth Ward of the City of Urbana.

WILLIAM H. SCOTT to be elected as Alderman in the Fifth Ward of the City of Urbana.

JOSEPH A. WHELAN, JR. to be elected as Alderman in the Sixth Ward of the City of Urbana.

WILLIAM T. CASTLE to be elected as Alderman in the Seventh Ward of the City of Urbana.
