Notice of said election was given by publishing the notice twice, once on March 16, 1979, in the Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette, and again on March 18, 1979, in the Champaign-Urbana Courier, which newspapers have general circulation within the City of Urbana, and which dates were not more than thirty days nor less than fifteen days in advance of the date of said election. The judges appointed by this City Council were duly qualified to fill such offices in each of the wards, and were duly sworn to perform their duties before the commencement of the said election. The returns of said election have been duly canvassed by said judges and the canvassing board and were filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana.
