

A RESOLUTION
ASCERTAINING PREVAILING WAGES

WHEREAS, Sections 4 and 9 of An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics And Other Workmen Employed In Any Public Works By The State, County, City Or Any Public Body Or Any Political Subdivision Or By Any One Under Contract For Public Works (Ill. Rev. Stats., Ch. 48, §§ 39s - 4 and 39s - 9) require the City Council to investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages for public works during the month of June of each calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Labor, pursuant to the same provisions of that Act, has furnished the City of Urbana with a certified copy of its findings ascertaining the prevailing rate of wages for Champaign County for the period of June, 1979 to June 30, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Prevailing Wages For Construction Trades, dated June 2, 1979, as submitted and certified by the Illinois Department of Labor for Champaign County for the period of June, 1979 to June 30, 1980, a copy of which is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same are hereby ascertained to be the prevailing rate of wages for public works in the City of Urbana.

Section 2. Nothing contained in this Resolution shall be deemed to apply, however, to housing rehabilitation by the Community Development Division of the City of Urbana as undertaken pursuant to the Community Development Program administered by the Housing and Urban Development Department of the United States Government.

THESE PREVAILING WAGES SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ADVERTISED SPECIFICATIONS FOR EVERY CONTRACT TO WHICH ANY PUBLIC BODY, AS DEFINED IN CHAPTER 48, SECTION 39-S, ILL. REV. STAT., IS A PARTY. FOR CONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR, INCLUDING PAINTING AND REDECORATING, OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS OR PUBLIC WORKS WITHIN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS WHICH REQUIRES OR INVOLVES THE EMPLOYMENT OF MECHANICS AND/OR LABORERS, THE MINIMUM WAGES, OVERTIME RATE AND FRINGE BENEFITS CERTIFIED HEREIN SHALL BE PAID AND THE SCALE OF WAGES TO BE PAID SHALL BE POSTED BY THE CONTRACTOR IN A PROMINENT AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE PLACE AT THE SITE OF WORK.
