A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RULE CONCERNING MANDATORY ADJOURNMENT

1. That the rule of the City Council establishing a mandatory adjournment time for all meetings of the Urbana City Council be and the same is hereby amended to now read as follows:

"There shall be a mandatory adjournment at 11:00 P.M.; provided, however, the meeting may be extended until 11:30 P.M. by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the aldermen/alder-women present, and may be extended for an additional thirty (30) minutes beyond 11:30 P.M. by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of all aldermen/alderwomen present.

- 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
- 3. This Resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of all the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the Council of the Council
