

A RESOLUTION
AMENDING THE RULE CONCERNING
MANDATORY ADJOURNMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the rule of the City Council establishing a
mandatory adjournment time for all meetings of the Urbana City
Council be and the same is hereby amended to now read as follows:

"There shall be a mandatory adjournment
at 11:00 P.M.; provided, however, the meeting
may be extended until 11:30 P.M. by a two-
thirds (2/3rds) vote of the aldermen/alder-
women present, and may be extended for an
additional thirty (30) minutes beyond 11:30 P.M.
by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of all aldermen/
alderwomen present.

2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its passage and approval.

3. This Resolution is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a two-thirds (2/3rds)
vote of all the members of the Council of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 2nd day
of June, 1980.
