

RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT BY MUNICIPALITY UNDER THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois

that the following described street(s) be improved under the Illinois Highway Code:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

1. That the proposed improvement consist of modernization of railroad flashing signals which is as follows: installation of a new signal pole with signal head, lens, and crossbucks; installation of new relay case; installation of new cable and conduit; and other incidental construction

construction feet wide and shall be designated as Section 76-00209-00-SP

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$ 1,368.74 Dollars (\$ 1,368.74) for the improvement of said section from the municipality's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.

3. That said work shall be done by day labor; and,
