

A RESOLUTION
TO ESTABLISH REVIEW OF LIQUOR HEARINGS
ON THE RECORD TO BE ADOPTED BY CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, is a home rule municipal corporation of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 43, Section 153, provides that:

"In the event an appeal is taken from an order of a local liquor control commissioner of a home rule municipality of less than 500,000 inhabitants, the appeal shall be limited to a review of the official record of the proceedings of such local liquor control commissioner if the city council has adopted a resolution requiring that review be on such record."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that effective upon the passage of this resolution, all review or appeal of the actions or orders of the local liquor control commissioner of the City of Urbana, Illinois, shall be made by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission on the official record made before the local liquor control commissioner.
