A RESOLUTION OF PROTEST

WHEREAS, Bank of Illinois as Trustee under Trust #874, has petitioned for a proposed map amendment concerning a site on U.S. Route 45 North currently occupied by D & R Welding and a warehouse for lease; and

WHEREAS, the said proposal is being considered by the various governmental authorities concerned under the style and name of "Case No. CCZBA 394-AM-80; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and public hearing on the said question, the Urbana Plan Commission forwarded its recommendation to the Urbana City Council that the Urbana City Council protest the proposed map amendment to the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance, contained in Case No. CCZBA 394-AM-80; and

- 3. Aldeen, Attorney at Law, 1400 Frontage Road, Champaign, Illinois 61820, as Attorney for the Petitioner by certified mail at their respective addresses as shown above.
